**Approval of Minutes:**

## **Marijuana Cultivation**

- HPNA has not been invited to comment on any more projects. New applications take months to get to stage of comment invitation
- New application on 24th by Two Rivers: much closer to the houses than prior CUP applications. But, has not been sent to HPNA yet by City for comment.
- HPNA is not doing any more comment letters until the City provides a public workshop for the neighborhood

## **Other Business**

- Oct 23 6:00pm – SLPNA and Sierra Center hosting an event that is a community discussion on homelessness affecting local neighborhoods – request that we promote it and pass along comments/questions from residents?
- Application for Vacant Board Position: Megan
  - 6-year resident of HP
  - Community and labor organizing background
  - Vote: DS motion, KF seconded. Yes: 7 No: 0
- Knight Way
  - Neighbor asked about whether street lights are a possibility.
  - EN has already investigated; street lights are paid for when neighborhoods are created. Now, the street residents would have to pay for the cost as their own district. Very costly. And requires 66% of residents to agree. EN will send information to DS.
- Neighborhood comment submission for HPNA comment letters
  - General meeting is not appropriate forum for formal comments. DS made this announcement at start of last general meeting.
  - Must be by email or letter with personal information so that it can be accounted for by HPNA
  - And, for marijuana CUPs there was a deadline. Comments received after the deadline were not considered.
