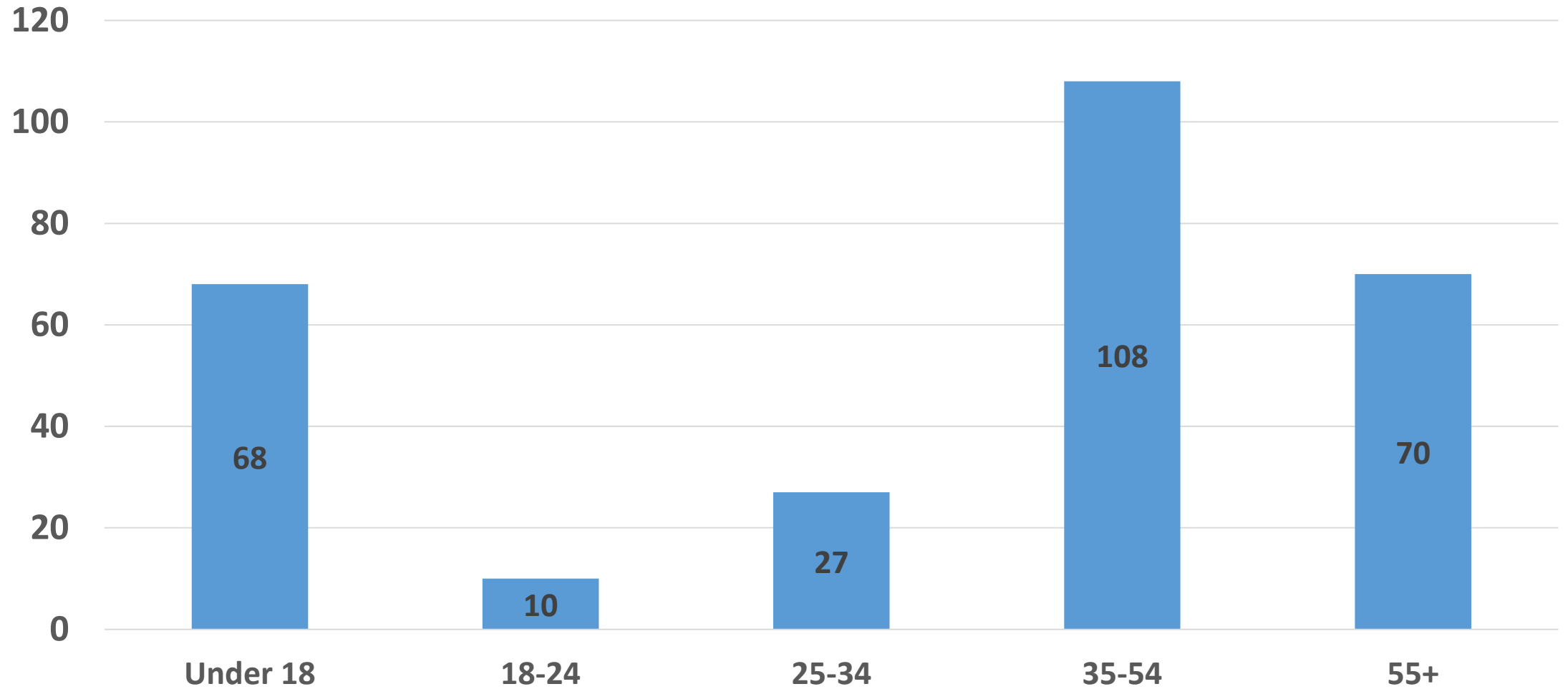


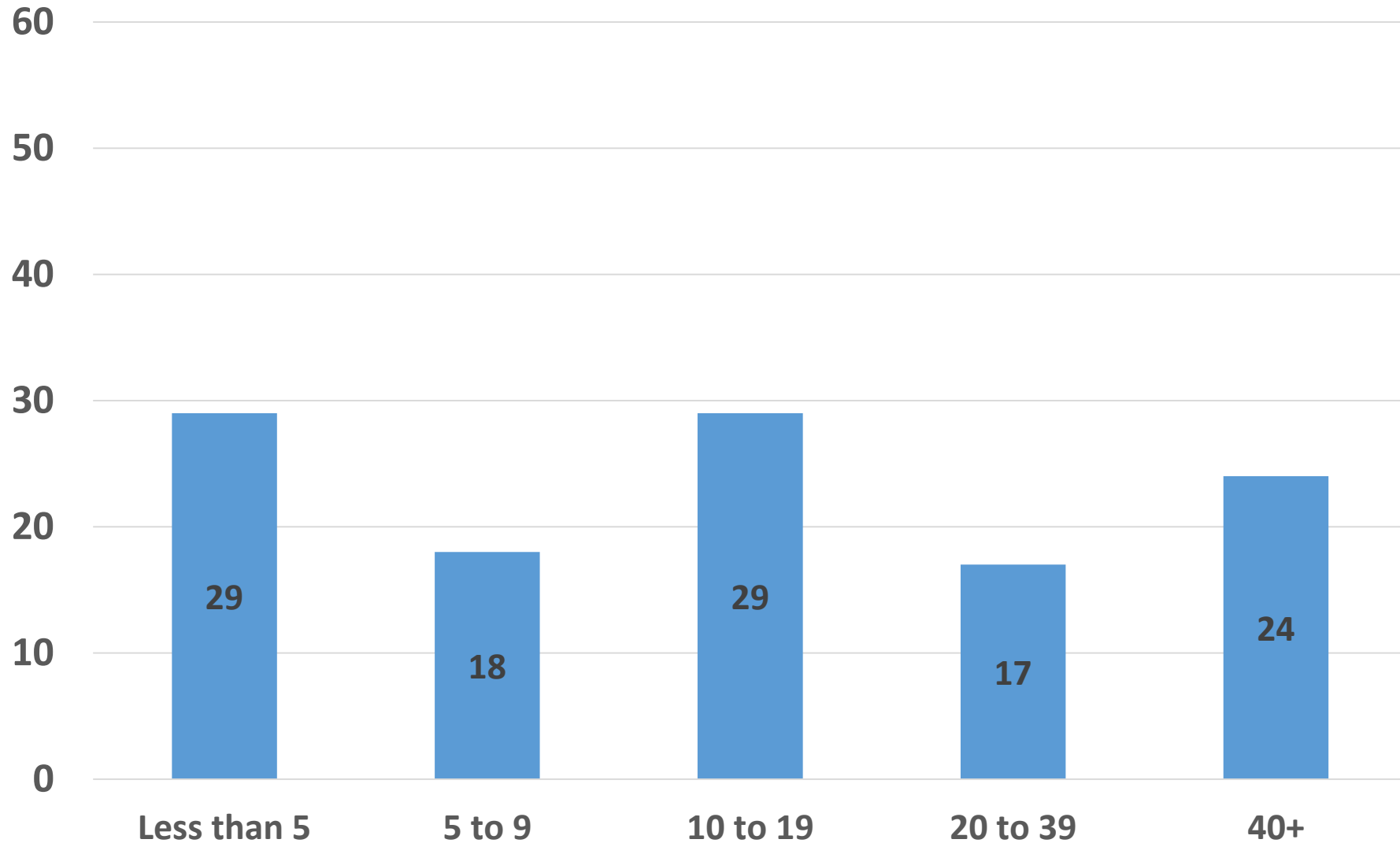

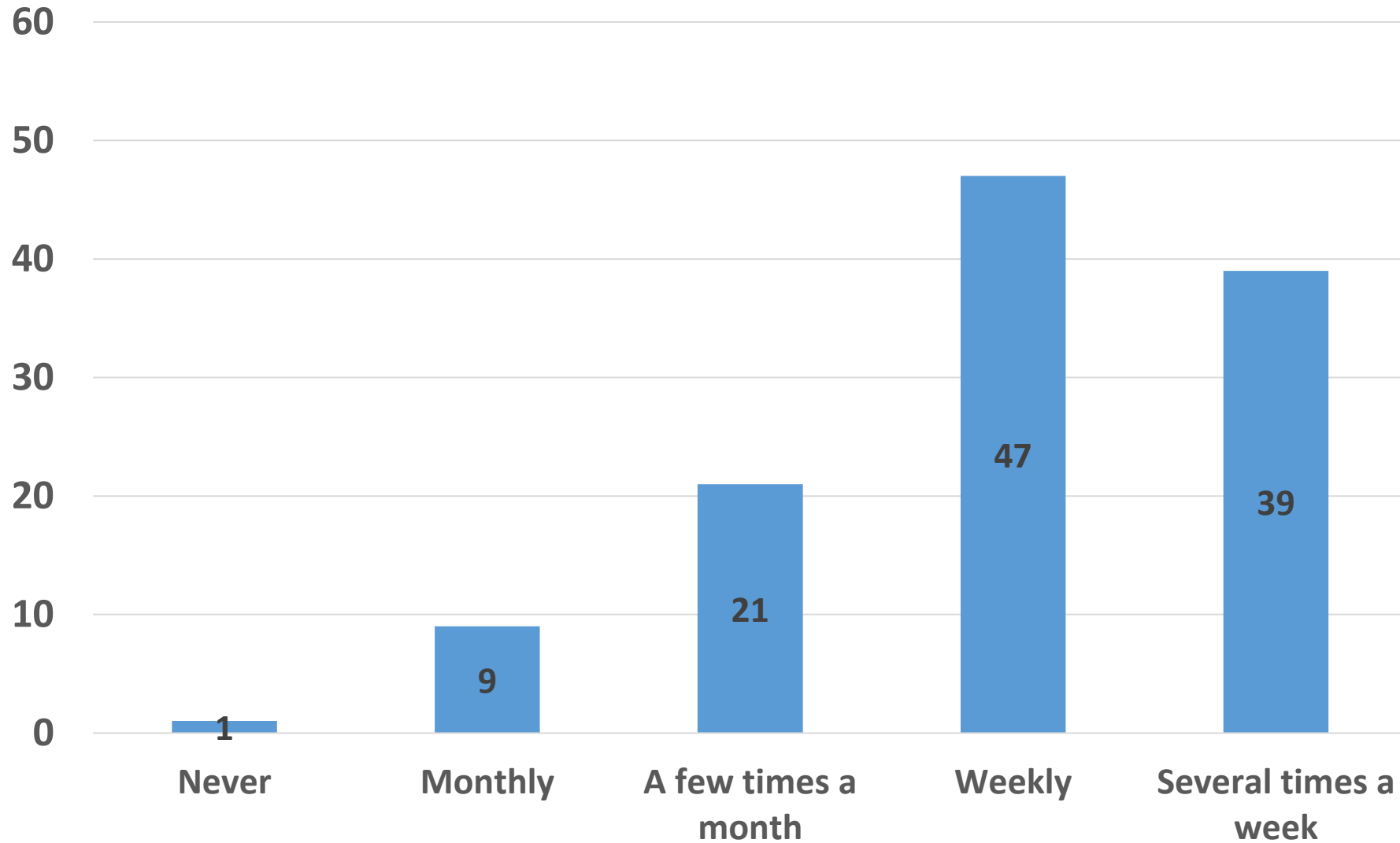
How many people currently live in your household and what are their ages?



Approximately how many years have you lived in Hollywood Park?

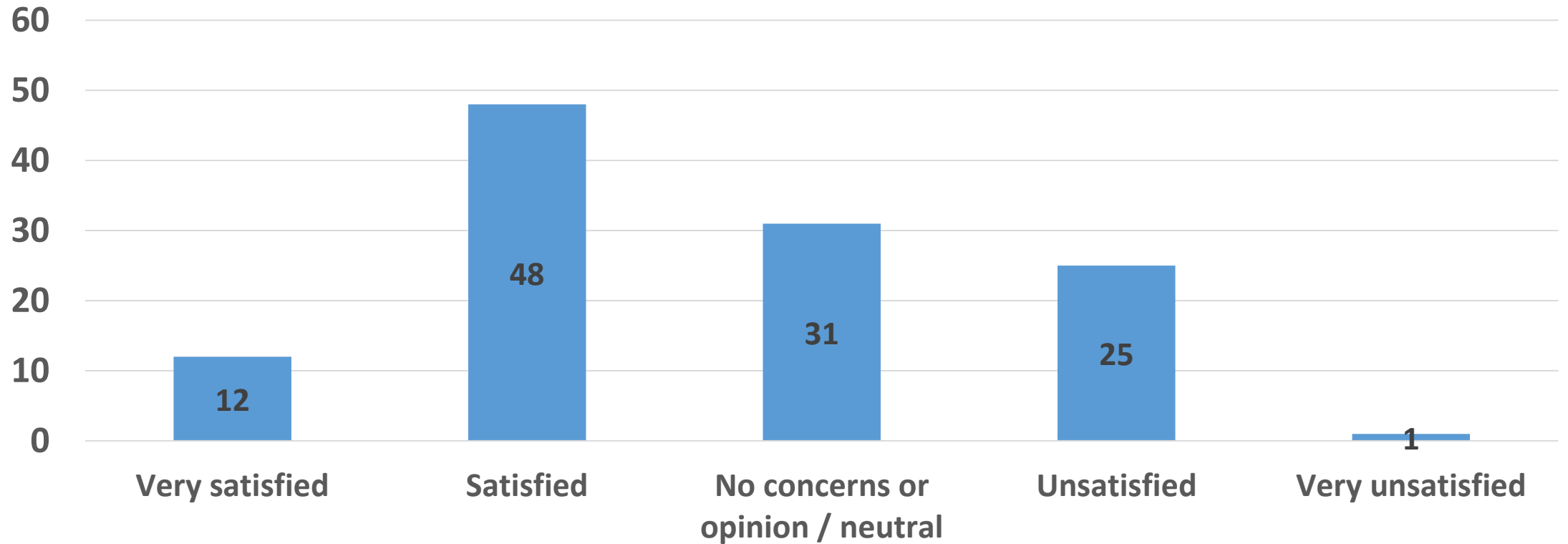


Please indicate how often your household patronizes neighborhood businesses?



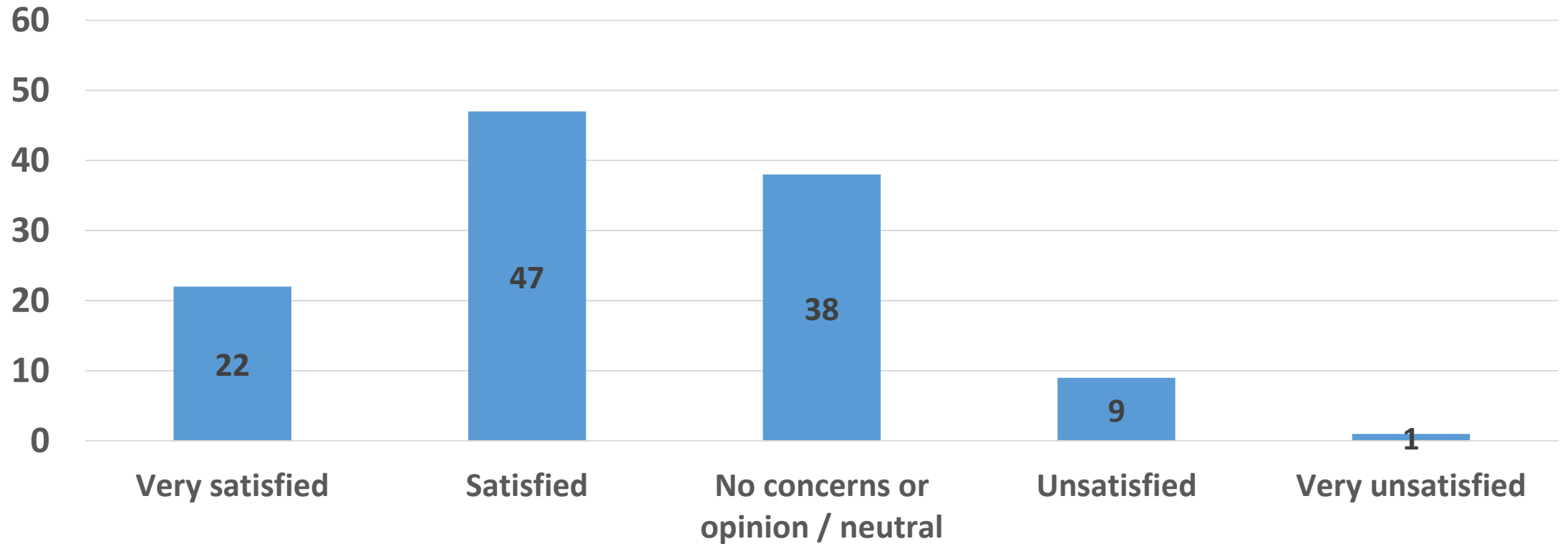

Property crime levels



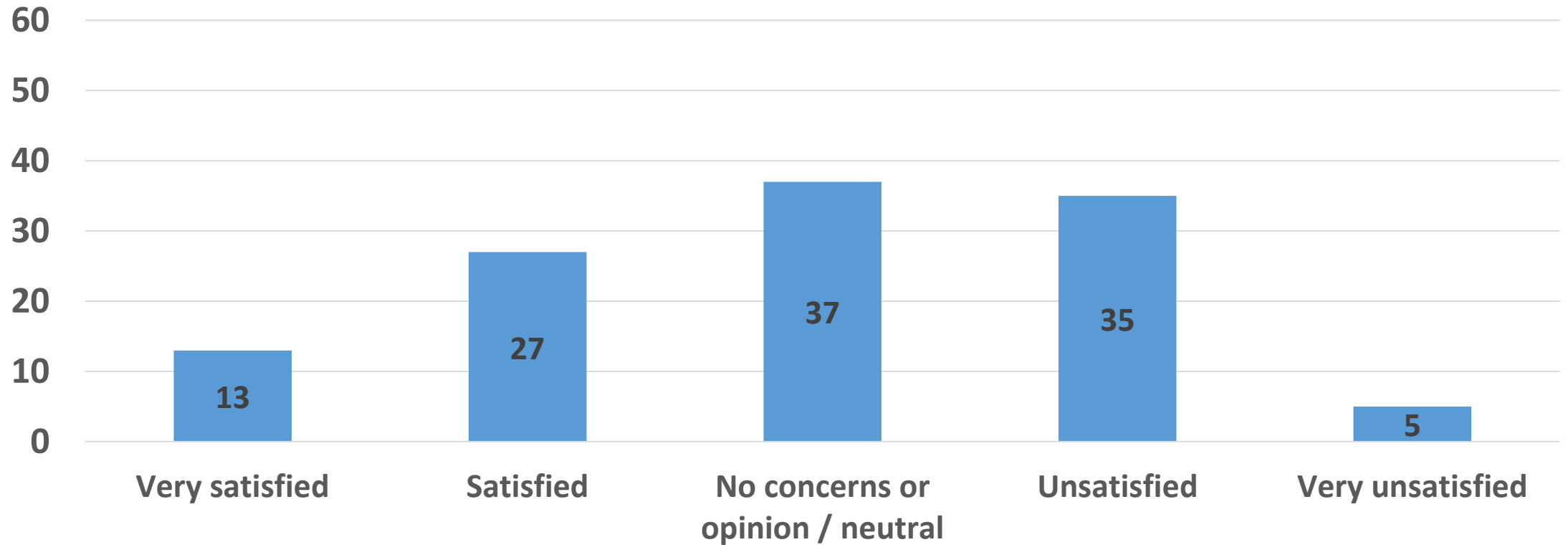

Personal crime levels



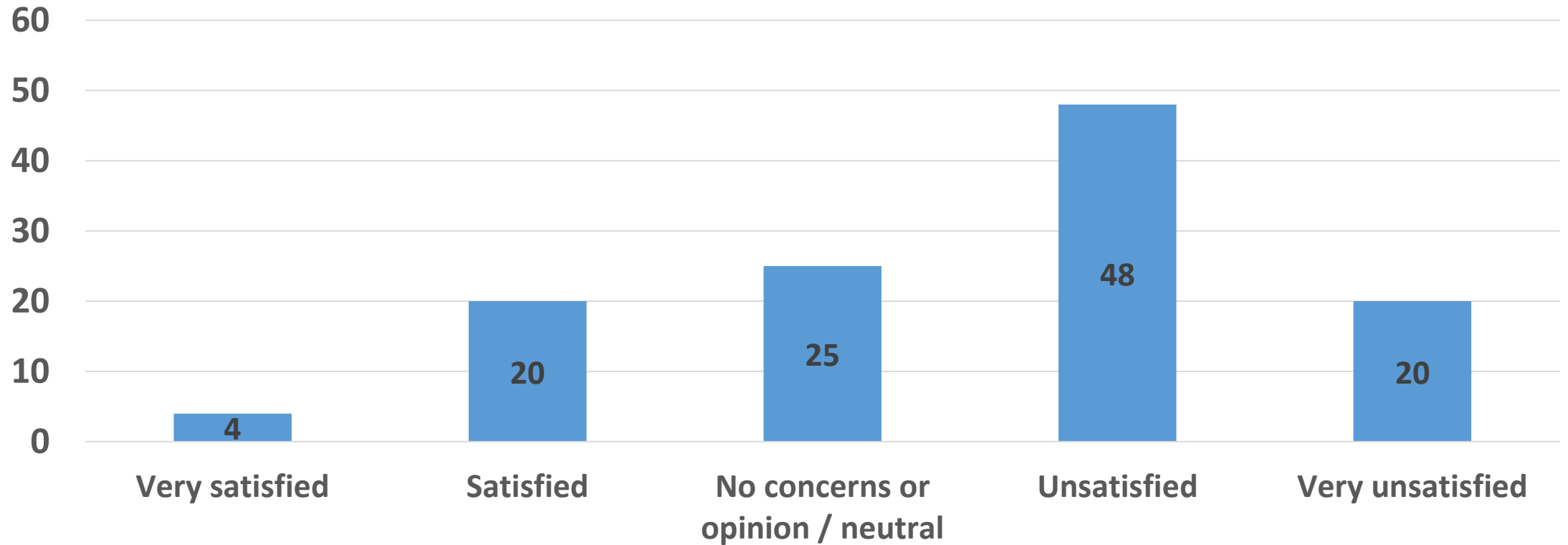

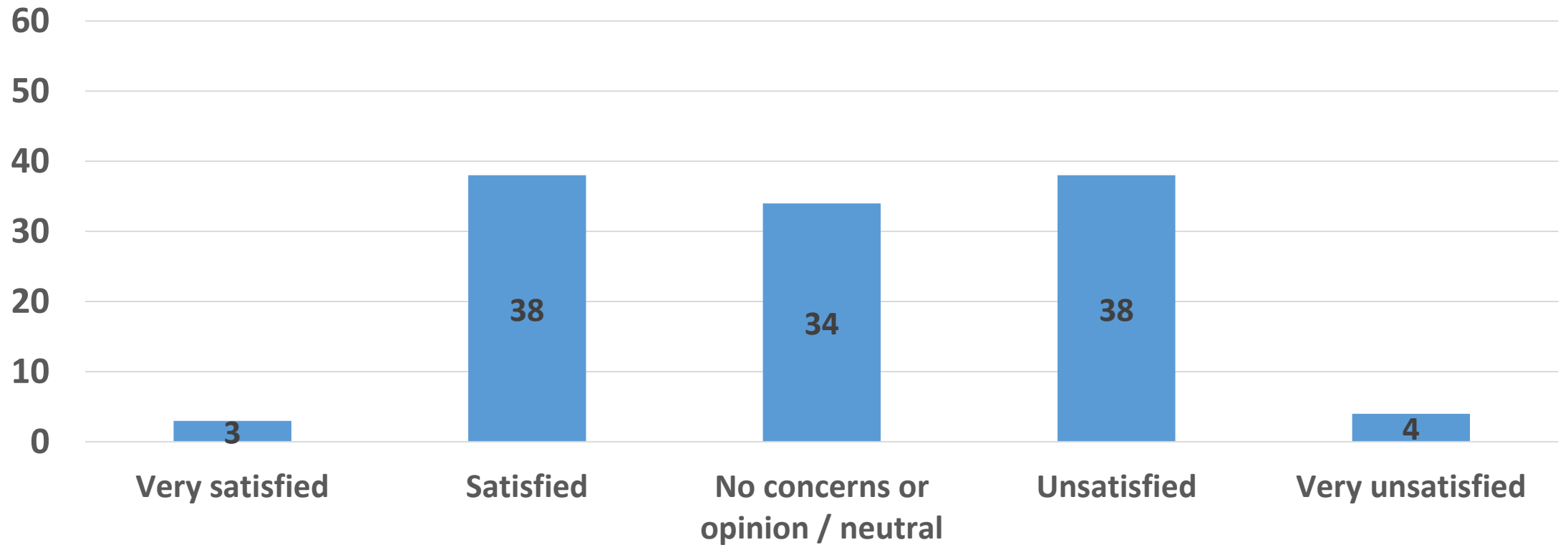

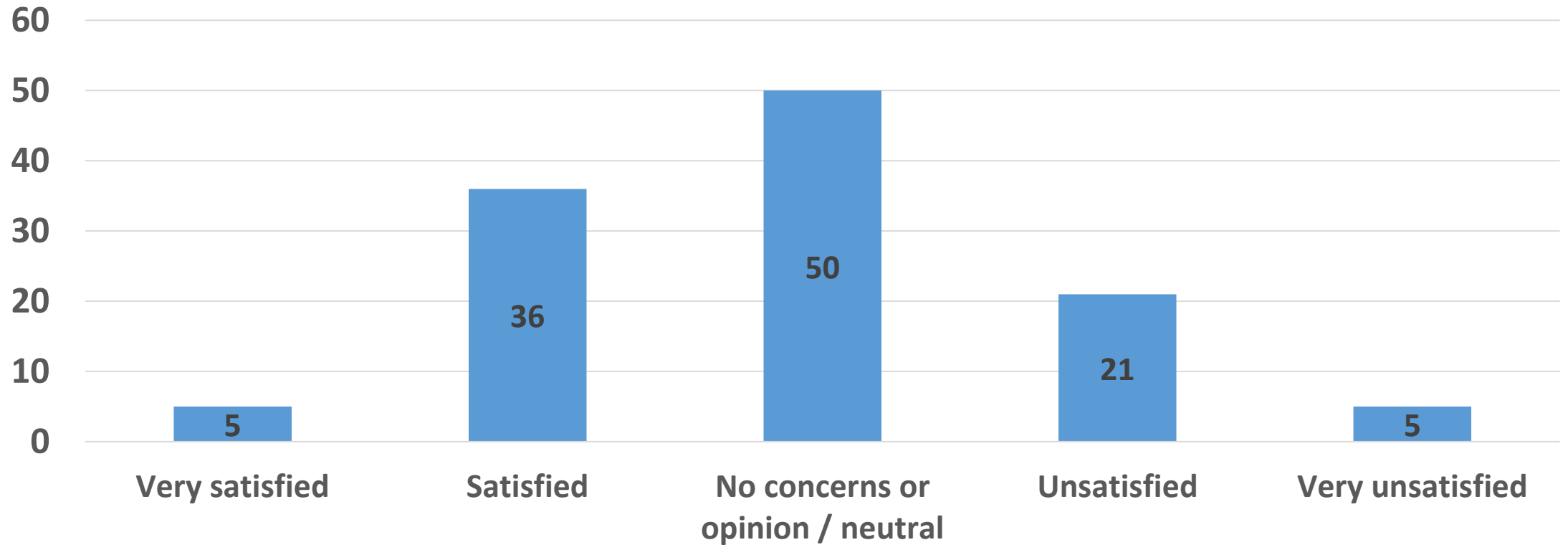

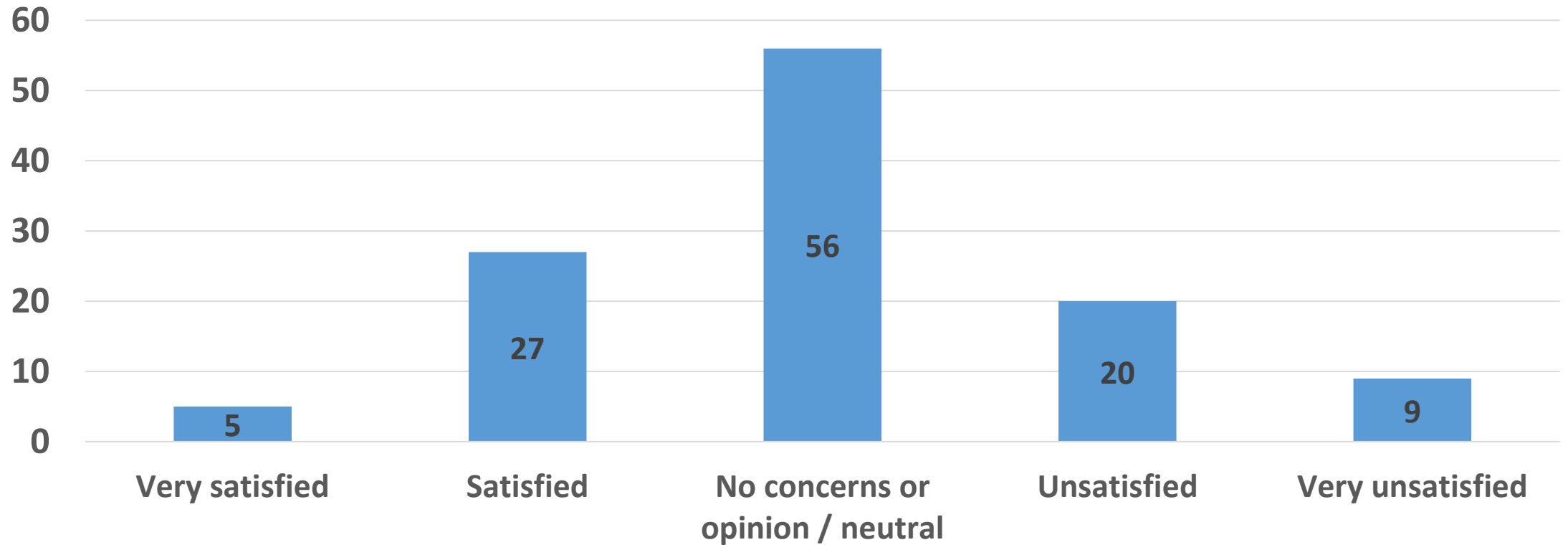

Congestion from neighborhood businesses



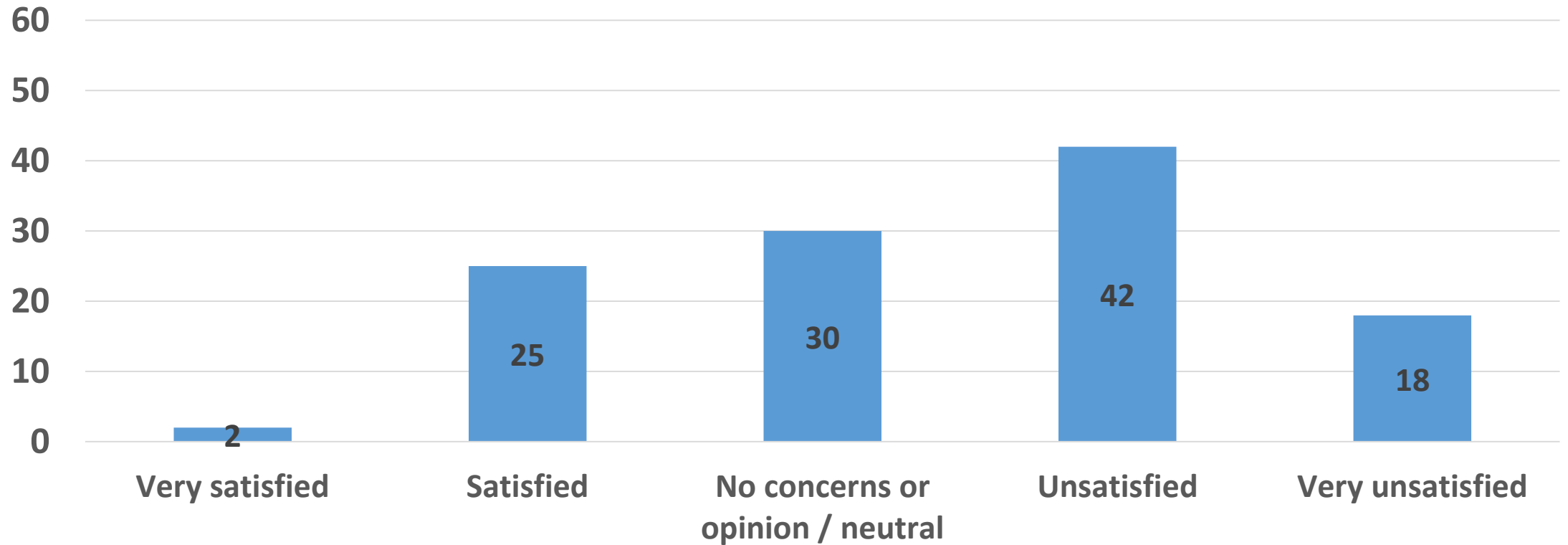

Congestion from neighborhood schools



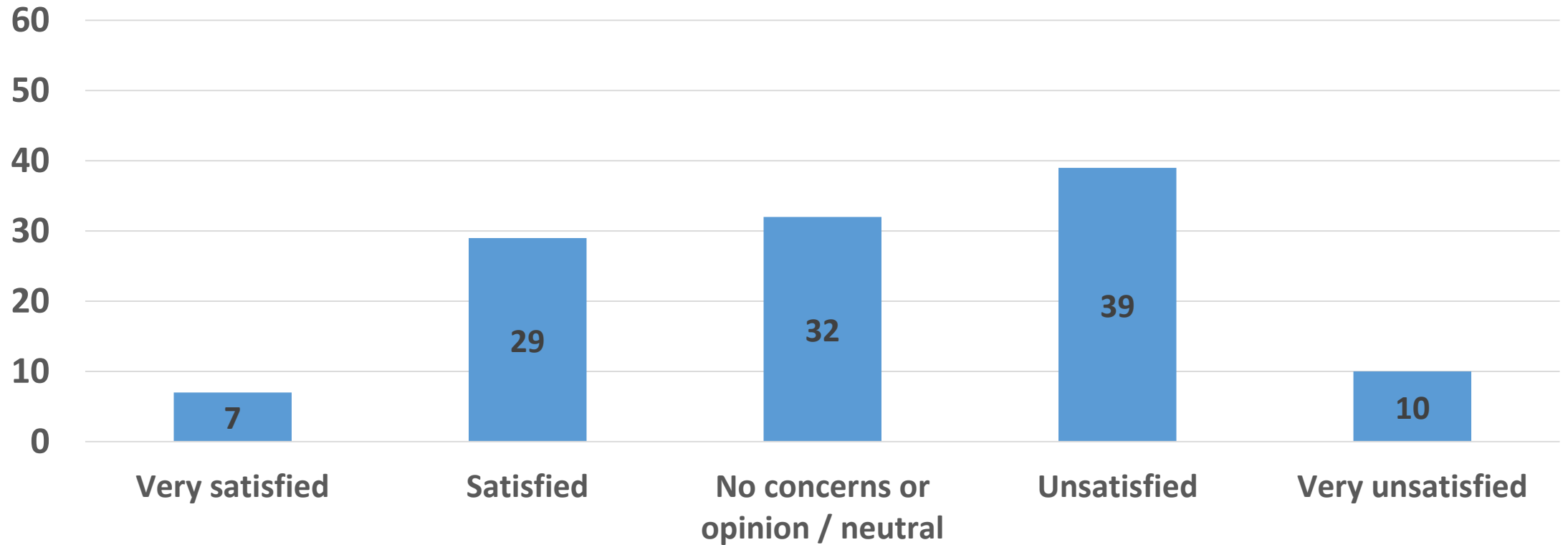

Traffic safety on main border streets



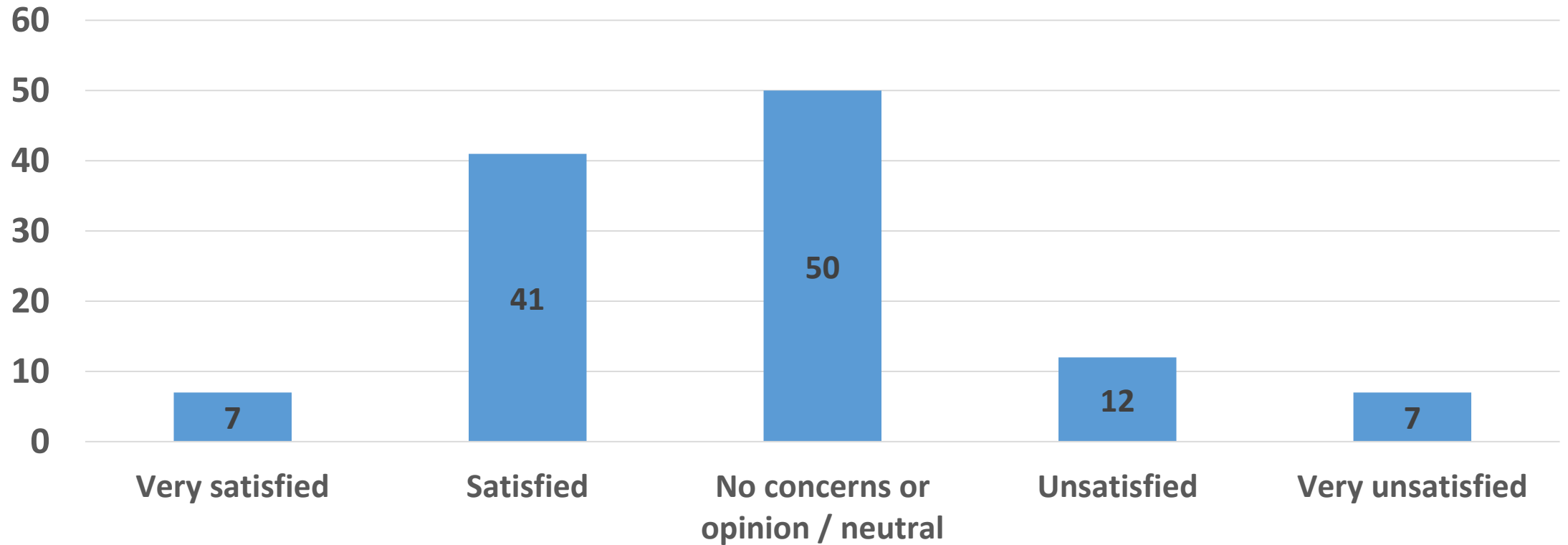

Traffic safety on residential streets

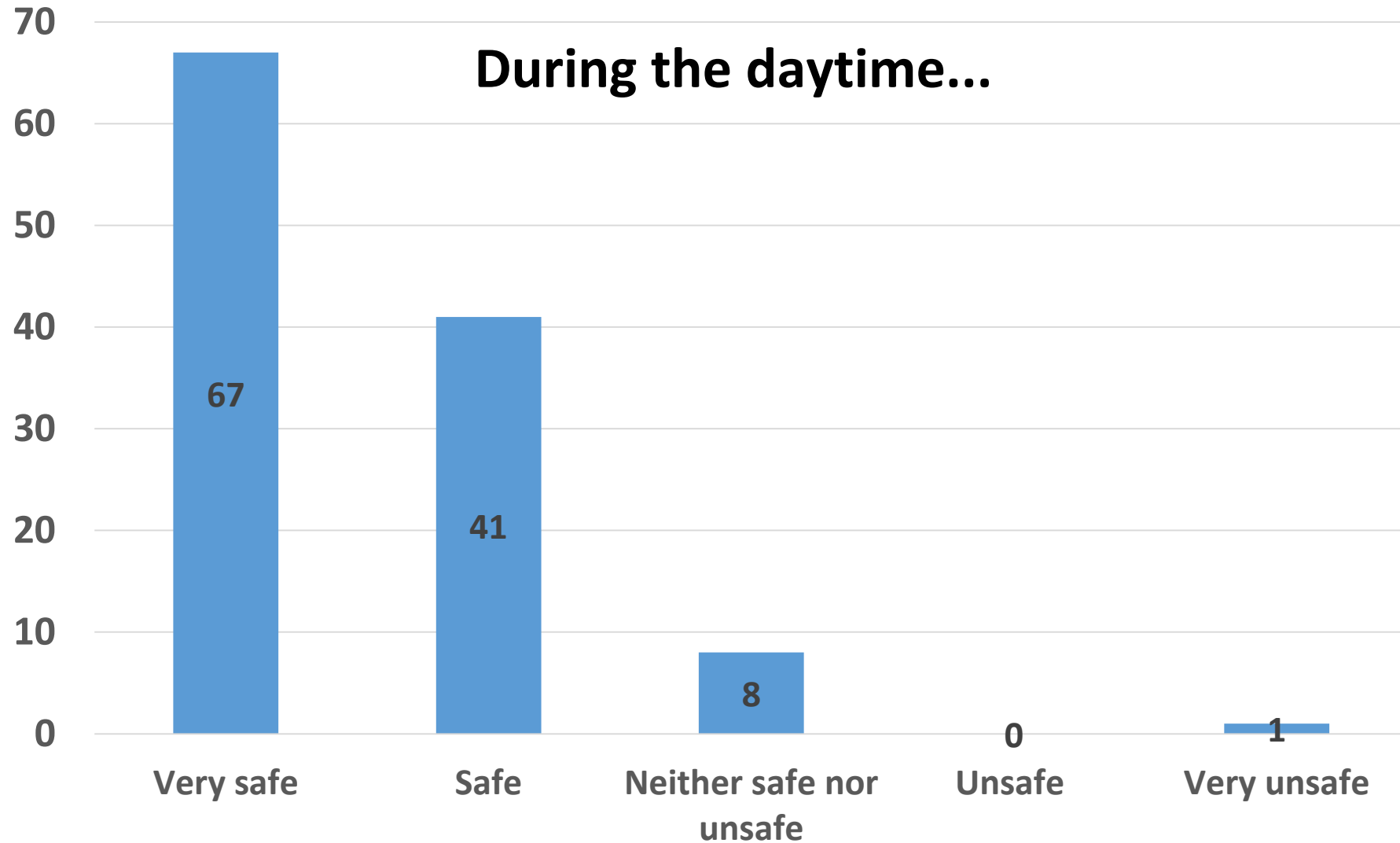

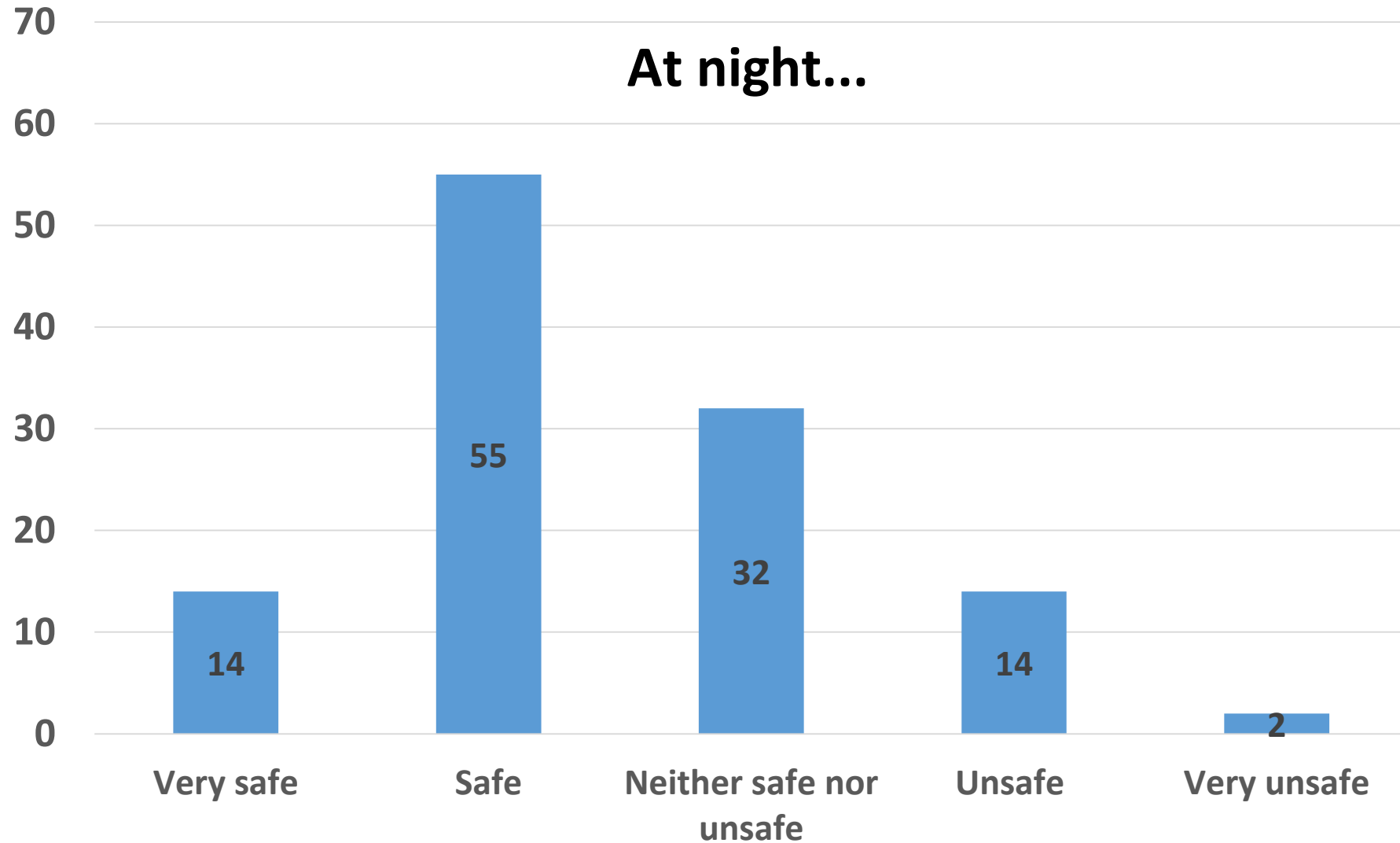

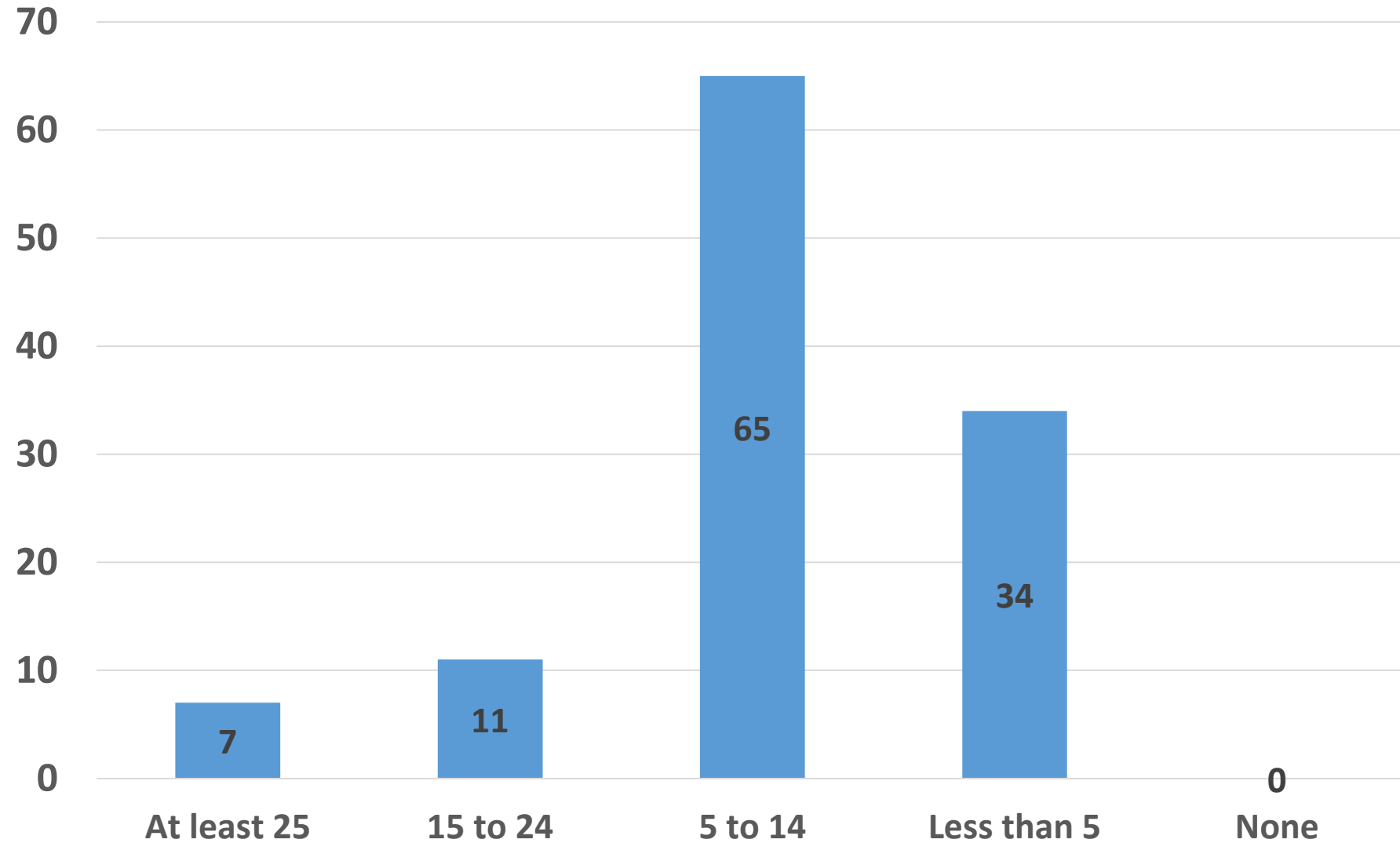
In the area within a few blocks of your home, how safe do you feel alone in the streets?



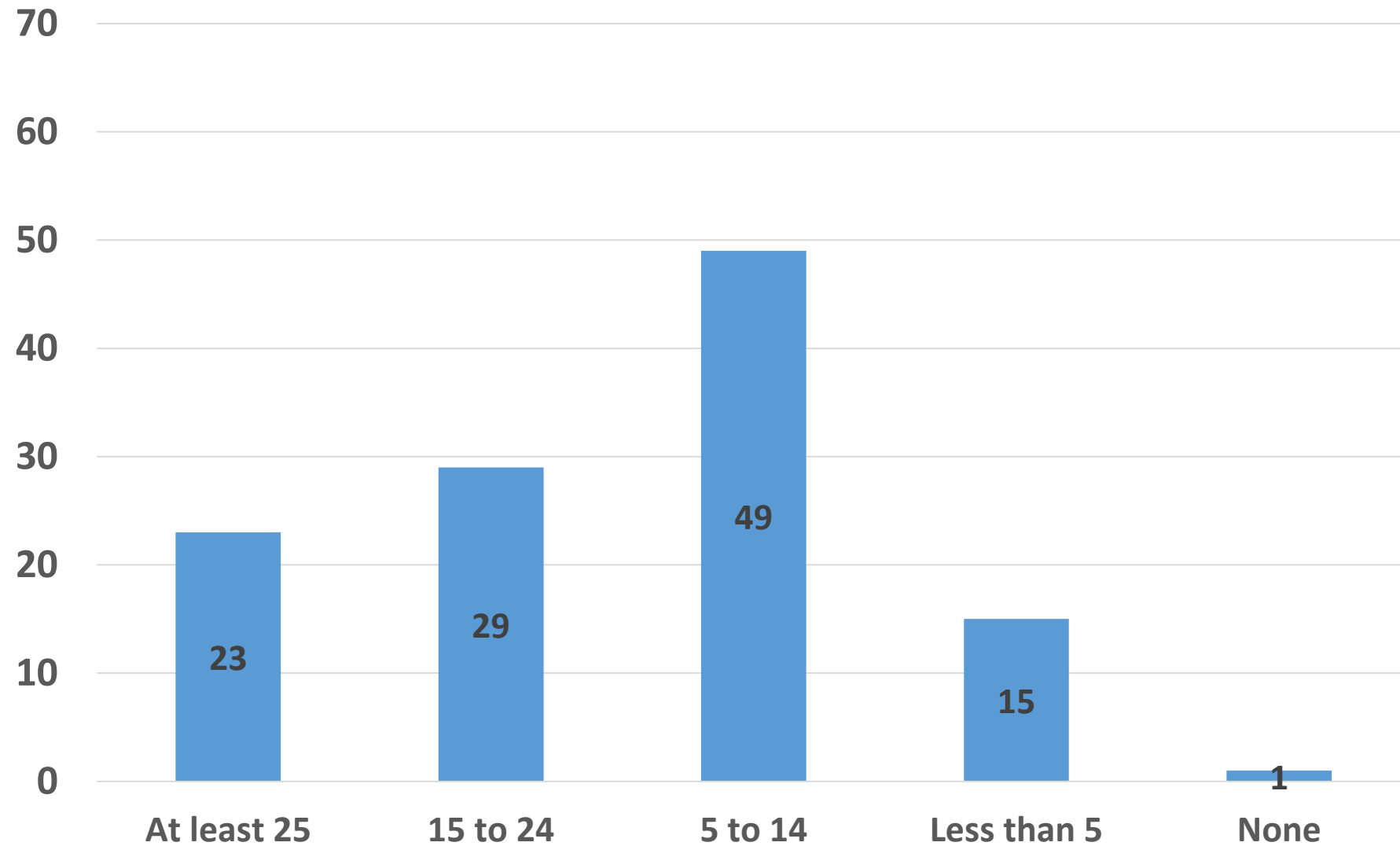
In the area within a few blocks of your home, how safe do you feel alone in the streets?



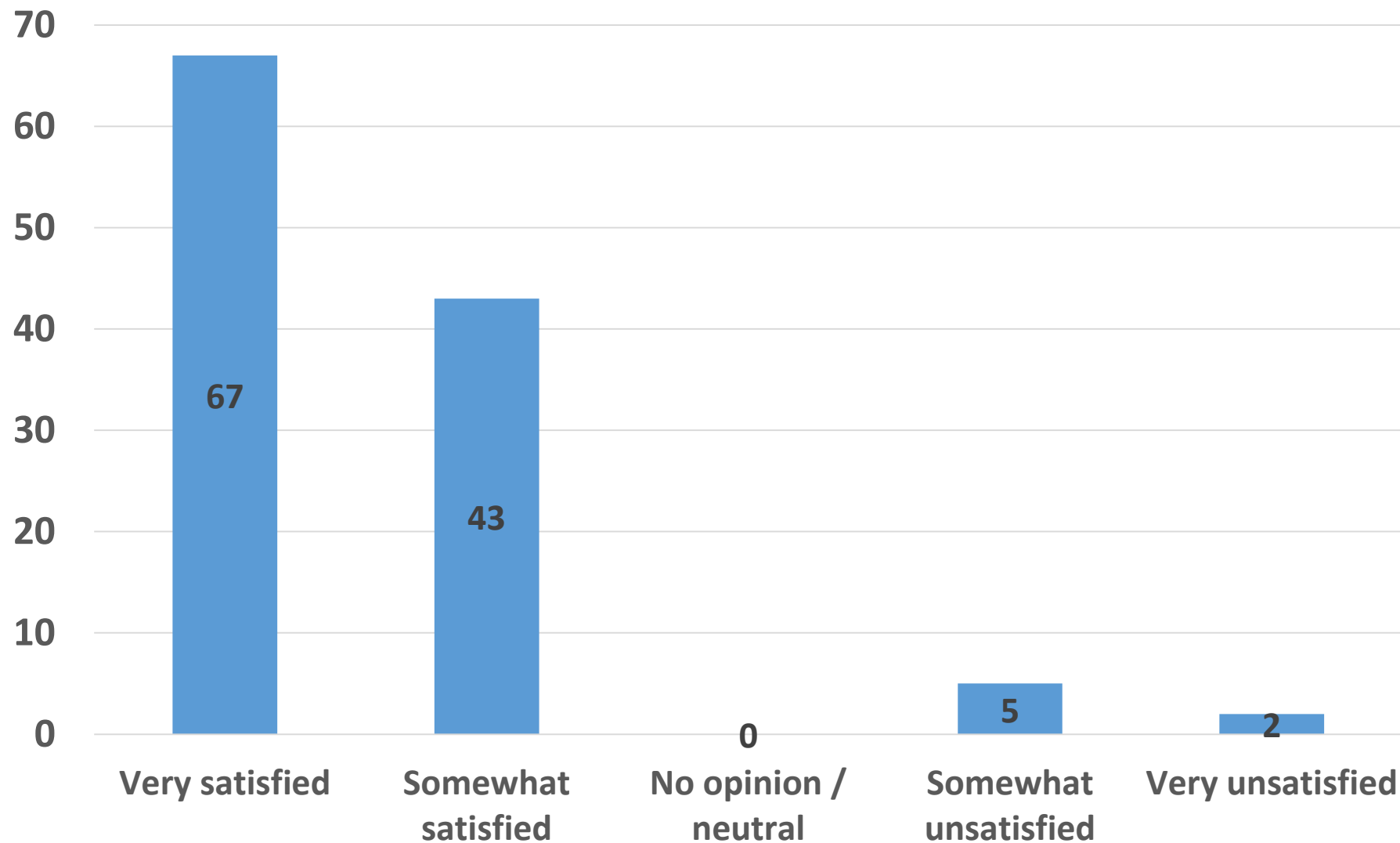
How many of your neighbors do you know by name? On your street/block...



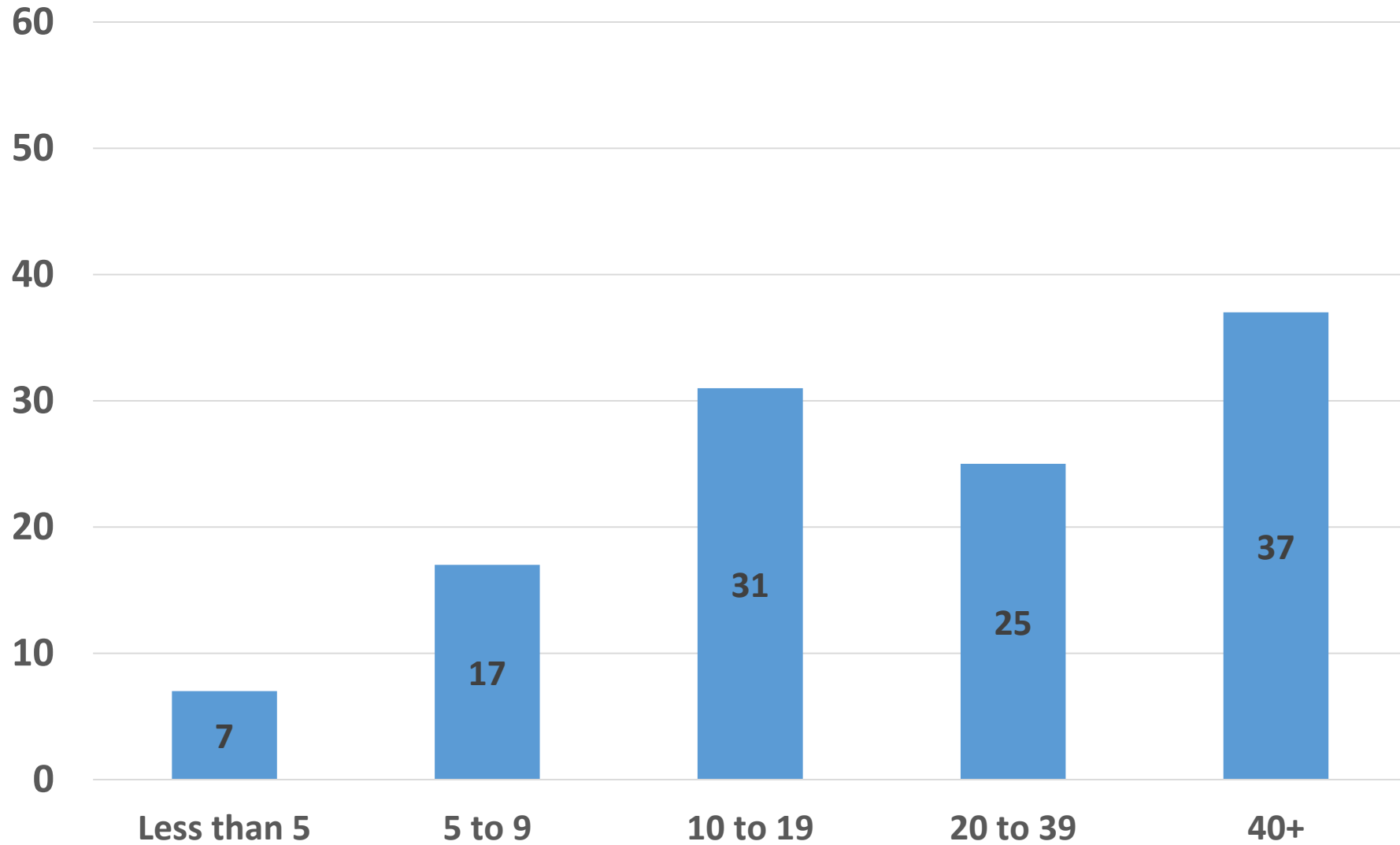
How many of your neighbors do you know by name? Within Hollywood Park...
